

How Do I Reset My Domain Password via OWA?

Answer:

1. To reset your password via Outlook OWA, you must first [register](#) for **self-service password reset**.
 - a. When registering for the self-service password reset, you must have two security methods in place so as to be able to reset your password; the recommended reset methods are personal e-mail account, cell phone, or security questions
2. Once you have registered your password reset methods, you may now proceed to [reset your password](#) online. For further reference, please see Microsoft's [Password Reset](#) guide.
3. If you do not need to reset your password but would like to change it before it expires:
 - a. Log in to your Outlook account through the [Office 365 Website](#).
 - b. Navigate to your Profile Tab and Click **My Account**.
 - c. On the Account page, click **Manage Security & Privacy**.
 - d. Change your password using the criteria below:

Office 365 Password Requirements

The password requirements for Office 365 are as follows:

- Passwords must be at least eight characters long.
- Passwords can have a maximum of 16 characters.
- Passwords can't contain the user's account name or parts of the user's full name that exceed two consecutive characters.

Passwords must contain characters from three of the following four categories:

- Uppercase letters (A through Z)
- Lowercase letters (a through z)
- Numbers (0 through 9)
- The following non-alphabetic characters: ` ~ ! @ # \$ % ^ & * () _ + - = { } | [] \ : " ; ' < > ? , . /
